

PROPHECIES OF JESUS CHRIST

Jesus Christ fulfilled over 300 prophecies from the Old Testament. These prophecies include details about His birth, life, and death, all of which were written centuries before He was born. The chance that any man might have fulfilled just eight prophecies is 1 in 100,000,000,000,000,000. A lot of these prophecies were out of His and His followers control making their fulfillment astronomical.

LINE OF DAVID

Prophecy - [Isaiah 11:1-3 \(NIV\)](#) "A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit. The Spirit of the Lord will rest on him—the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of might, the Spirit of the knowledge and fear of the Lord—and he will delight in the fear of the Lord."



Fulfillment by Jesus - [Matthew 1:1-17 \(NIV\)](#) "This is the genealogy of Jesus the Messiah the son of David, the son of Abraham..."

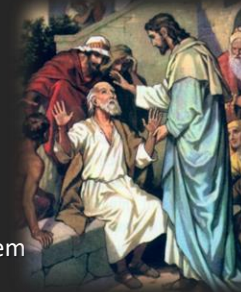
BIRTH IN BETHLEHEM



Fulfillment by Jesus - [Matthew 2:1 \(NIV\)](#) "After Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the time of King Herod, Magi from the east came to Jerusalem."

HEALING MINISTRY

Prophecy - [Isaiah 35:5-6 \(NIV\)](#) – "Then will the eyes of the blind be opened and the ears of the deaf unstopped..."



Fulfillment by Jesus - [John 9:6-7 \(NIV\)](#) "After saying this, He spit on the ground, made some mud with the saliva, and put it on the man's eyes. "Go," He told him, "wash in the Pool of Siloam" (this word means "Sent"). So the man went and washed, and came home seeing."

TRIUMPHAL ENTRY

Prophecy - [Zechariah 9:9 \(NIV\)](#) "Rejoice greatly, Daughter Zion! Shout, Daughter Jerusalem! See, your King comes to you, righteous and victorious, lowly and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey."

Fulfillment by Jesus - [John 12:12-15 \(NIV\)](#) "The next day the great crowd that had come for the festival heard that Jesus was on His way to Jerusalem. They took palm branches and went out to meet Him, shouting, "Hosanna!" "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" "Blessed is the



King of Israel!" Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it, as it is written: "Do not be afraid, Daughter Zion; see, your King is coming, seated on a donkey's colt."

DESPISED & PERSECUTED

Prophecy - [Isaiah 53:3 \(NIV\)](#) "He was despised and rejected by mankind, a Man of suffering, and familiar with pain. Like one from whom people hide their faces He was despised, and we held Him in low esteem."

Fulfillment by Jesus - [John 1:10-11 \(NIV\)](#) "He was in the world, and though the world was made through Him, the world did not recognize Him. He came to that which was His own, but His own did not receive Him."



LAMB TO SLAUGHTER

Prophecy - [Isaiah 53:7 \(NIV\)](#) "He was oppressed and afflicted, yet He did not open His mouth; He was led like a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before its shearers is silent, so He did not open His mouth."

Fulfillment by Jesus - [Mark 15:2-5 \(NIV\)](#) "Are you the king of the Jews?" asked Pilate. "You have said so," Jesus replied. The chief priests accused Him of many things. So again Pilate asked Him, "Aren't You going to answer? See how many things they are accusing You of." But Jesus still made no reply, and Pilate was amazed."



CRUSHED FOR OUR SINS

Prophecy - [Isaiah 53:5-6 \(NIV\)](#) "But He was pierced for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on Him, and by His wounds we are healed. We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way; and the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all."

Fulfillment by Jesus - [1 Peter 2:24 \(NIV\)](#) "He Himself bore our sins" in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; "by His wounds you have been healed."

CLOTHES DIVIDED



Prophecy - Psalm 22:17-18 (NIV) "All My bones are on display; people stare and gloat over Me. They divide My clothes among them and cast lots for My garment."

Fulfillment by Jesus - John 19:23 (NIV) "When the soldiers crucified Jesus, they took his clothes, dividing them into four shares, one for each of them, with the undergarment remaining. This garment was seamless, woven in one piece from top to bottom."

CHRIST CRUCIFIED



Prophecy - Psalm 22:14-16 (NIV) "I am poured out like water, and all My bones are out of joint. My heart has turned to wax; it has melted within Me. My mouth is dried up like a potsherd, and My tongue sticks to the roof of My mouth; you lay Me in the dust of death. Dogs surround Me, a pack of villains encircles Me; they pierce My hands and My feet."

Fulfillment by Jesus – Galatians 3:13 (NIV) "Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a pole."

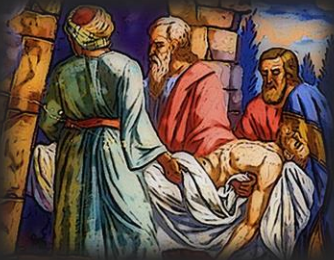
BONES UNBROKEN



Prophecy - Numbers 9:12 (NIV) "They must not leave any of it till morning or break any of its bones. When they celebrate the Passover, they must follow all the regulations."

Fulfillment by Jesus - John 19:32-35 (NIV) "The soldiers therefore came and broke the legs of the first man who had been crucified with Jesus, and then those of the other. But when they came to Jesus and found that he was already dead, they did not break his legs."

RICH MAN'S GRAVE



Prophecy - Isaiah 53:9 (NIV) "He was assigned a grave with the wicked, and with the rich in His death, though He had done no violence, nor was any deceit in His mouth."

Fulfillment by Jesus – Matthew 27:57-60 (NIV) "As evening approached, there came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph, who had himself become a disciple of Jesus. Going to Pilate, he asked for Jesus' body, and Pilate ordered that it be given to him. Joseph took the body, wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, and placed it in his own new tomb that he had cut out of the rock. He rolled a big stone in front of the entrance to the tomb and went away."

RESURRECTION



Prophecy – Psalm 16:10 (NIV) "because you will not abandon Me to the realm of the dead, nor will You let Your faithful One see decay."

Fulfillment by Jesus – Matthew 28:2-6 (NIV) "There was a violent earthquake, for an angel of the Lord came down from heaven and, going to the tomb, rolled back the stone and sat on it. His appearance was like lightning, and his clothes were white as snow. The guards were so afraid of him that they shook and became like dead men. The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He is not here; He has risen, just as He said. Come and see the place where He lay."

RIGHTHAND OF THE FATHER



Prophecy - Psalm 110:1 (NIV) "Of David. A psalm. The LORD says to my Lord: "Sit at My right hand until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet."

Fulfillment by Jesus - Hebrews 10:12-13 (NIV) "But when this Priest had offered for all time one sacrifice for sins, He sat down at the right hand of God, and since that time He waits for His enemies to be made His footstool."
